


# KEY W **MILESTONES**

## **CHILDREN**

**Nursery Care**: The nursery is staffed with experienced childcare workers who provide a loving and caring environment for infants and preschoolers. A brief lesson is provided each week and adult caregivers are provided additional resources to use at home.

Children's Sunday School: Children's Sunday School is offered to children age three through fifth grade. Each week, children can learn more about God and God's people through hands-on activities such as movement, singing, different art mediums, or the five senses. Adult caregivers are provided resources for at-home faith formation.

**Prayground:** During Worship, children may use our playground space in the sanctuary. This space allows kids to participate fully in the service through age-appropriate activities as they worship with our church family. Adult facilitators model, guide, and help children throughout the service.

**Northminster Kids:** We provide monthly gatherings on Sunday evenings for kids to grow in faith and fellowship with one another! Activities, mission projects, art, and games are some examples of the gatherings. Check our website for the schedule.

**Intergenerational Ministry**: Northminster believes that children, youth, and adults can grow in faith together through intergenerational ministry opportunities. We gather throughout the year for learning, mission, and faith growing opportunities where all ages are invited to participate together.
